


Another Library in Your Own Backyard



What is Reciprocal Borrowing?

TBLC member libraries with Reciprocal Borrowing Agreements have agreed to let users from other TBLC participating libraries walk in and check out physical library books, free of charge. Usually, library users will use the same library card their home library has issued to them. This program does not allow you to use any eResources such as eBooks, online databases, etc. from the participating libraries.
